
MISSION

The purpose of the Great Lakes Gabriel Project is to advance the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Church and to respond to Pope John Paul II's call for a New Evangelization to bring about a "Culture of Life" and "Civilization of Love." We do this by supporting women in unplanned pregnancies and conducting activities that promote recognition of the dignity and sanctity of human life from conception to natural death.

SERVICES

We accompany and empower our mothers throughout their pregnancy journey and beyond. We provide a range of direct and indirect support including transportation, connecting them to community resources, providing limited financial help, and material assistance.

We partner with a network of churches by providing information about pregnancy options including parenting, the truth about abortion, and lovingly placing for adoption. We offer practical help for women and families experiencing difficult or unplanned pregnancies. Currently, the Gabriel Project works with numerous congregations covering Central and Southern Indiana with a multitude of volunteers including "Angels" who individually support and mentor mothers.

FUNDING

The Great Lakes Gabriel Project is 100% donor-funded. We rely on your support to meet the ongoing needs of our moms. We receive no state or federal funding. We operate within the Archdiocese of Indianapolis with their blessing, but do not receive any direct financial support from them. Our primary fundraiser is the annual dinner. Bright Future Ahead

After many years of searching, the Great Lakes Gabriel Project will reopen our 1st Choice for Women Pregnancy Center. The new center is located on the Southwest side of Indianapolis in an area that is underserved. The target date for opening is early 2025. The center will provide free pregnancy testing, free ultrasounds, and free life skills training, as well as offer information on parenting, the truth about abortion and placing for adoption.
